

MAKING SAFEGUARDING PERSONAL IN SOLIHULL – A PERSON CENTRED AND OUTCOMES APPROACH TO SAFEGUARDING ADULTS
REVIEWING OUTCOMES – AIDE MEMOIRE



At the end of the process – Case Conference or Case Closure, the individual's outcomes that were recorded must be evaluated to see if they have been:

- Met
- Partly Met or
- Not Met.

This evaluation must be undertaken with the individual who had identified the outcome and their perspectives as to if they have been met, partly met or not met.

Partly meeting or not meeting an individual's outcome should not be considered a failure.

Have things changed? How have they changed?

How do you feel that you/we have progressed towards the wishes and outcomes you identified?

Does the individual understand why their outcome has only been partly met or not met even if they are unhappy with the outcome?

What helped or prevented the achievements of outcomes?

Was there anything that could have been done differently?
